Write a short story set in the Tudor times. Try and include a simile or metaphor you could include.	Make a timeline of events and changes from this period. Use your knowledge of ordering numbers to make sure the events are accurately placed on the timeline.	Create a factual poster that could be displayed in the classroom about the Tudors. It needs to be eye-catching!
Research food in the Tudor times – write your own Tudor recipe. Can you correctly punctuate a bullet point list?	Create a graph that shows how long each of Henry VIII's lived for. Please ask your teacher for graph paper. What information can you get from your graph?	Research Tudor portraits and draw a self- portrait in the same style.
